Over 90,000 Canadians made their wishes known when they signed petition e-4623 which stated: *We, the undersigned, Citizens and Residents of Canada, call upon the House of Commons in Parliament assembled to urgently implement Canada's expeditious withdrawal from the UN and all of its subsidiary organizations, including the World Health Organization (WHO).* www.ourcommons.ca/petitions/en/Petition/Details?Petition=e-4623

This petition was filed on March 22, 2024 by Haldimand Norfolk MP & International law expert Dr. Leslyn Lewis.

In less than five weeks, someone representing Canadians will be tasked with ratifying the latest draft of the WHO's Pandemic Treaty as well as the amended 2005 International Health Regulations (IHR). Currently our representative has not been told to have Canada OPT OUT. No action taken means Canada will be submitting itself to all the terms of both documents. Attached you will find a listing of the top ten terms of the IHR that are unacceptable to Canadians. Once more Canadians become aware that currently, absent direction to the contrary, Canada will automatically be considered a signatory to these terms, many more Canadians will be demanding a pull-out.

In his response to a previous petition (asking for Parliamentary debate and discussion on WHO amendments) the Hon Minister of Health Mark Holland stated: *"Canada has full jurisdiction for any future domestic decisions about national restrictions or other measures related to health emergencies and pandemics. WHO Member States will continue to lead the process of negotiating amendments to the IHR (2005) and, as Canada engages in it, the federal government will ensure that Canadian priorities and values are upheld."* Yet Dr. Lewis pointed out: *"While your department's response to the online petition was meant to reassure Canadians that their healthcare sovereignty would not be compromised, several concerning amendments are now in force as a result of Canada's failure to reject the May 28, 2022 amendments."* She also explained that the very fact that the WHO is violating its own requirement to provide nations with a four month notice period on what is up for vote is another reason not to have Canada opt in.

Among the reasons for completely withdrawing from our membership within the World Health Organization is the admission in 2017 by the previous Director-General, Dr. Margaret Chan, that in order to remain strong, the WHO has essentially been "captured" by the wishes of its corporate donors. Currently, the WHO receives a more of its operating funds from agencies that represent pharmaceutical companies than from its own member states. Dr. Chan admitted that she needed to go around "with a hat" to literally "beg for money." She stated that those who give the money have "preferences" that may differ from the priorities of the WHO itself. In order for the federal government to, as Minister Holland put it, “ensure that Canadian priorities and values are upheld” I urge you, as my elected representative to do all you can to firmly request the immediate withdrawal of Canada from the WHO, the UN and their associated organizations.

Accountability and transparency, key Canadian values, are certainly being disregarded by those who are running the affairs of the World Health Organization these days. Likewise, that list of Top Ten Unacceptable Terms of the IHR weighs heavily on our minds and should be of great concern to you.

I look forward to your response, one that indicates how soon the federal government will take the wishes of Canadians at heart and remove ourselves from this compromised organization.
